
Use 160 gr. Cardboard to print. If you can, print the pdo in A4 format! You get a very good result in Colours if you print it in a copy shop with a digital laser printer!

To give the ship a better look, colour all cut edges! Clue cardboard inside as shown on the pics.

Green lines = Clue **Blue** = Cut **Red Dot** = clue cardboard behind  - important tip
Yellow Dot – Cardboard you maybe need later to clue behind a pice.

Main Door Hangar

Its very important to clue cardboard behind to stabilize and give the pice the correct form.




Inner Main Hangar



After cluing the inner hangar test if its fit into the “ring”. Bow the flaps of the inner ring in 180 degree. Turn outside part on head. Put clue around inner part and clue the parts together. After its dry clue the outside parts together.




⚠ leave enough space between cardboard pices and edges where you clue later the flaps of the top and bottom pices in.



Clue main and fighter part together.


